Beyond her personal accomplishments, this 57-year-old powerhouse provides employment opportunities to numerous young girls and inspires them to reach their fullest potential

"Never be scared of challenges and never let people dishearten your goals," advises Babli, encapsulating the essence of her journey.

Over the years, she has clinched more than 15 awards, including 14 Nationals and one International accolade, a testament to her indomitable spirit. Not just the CavinKare Ability Mastery Award in 2011, her remarkable journey was further acknowledged in 2013 when President Pranab Mukherjee felicitated her with the "Outstanding Creative Adult Person Award (female)" during the National Awards for Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities in New Delhi.
